The Bellingham Yacht Club leases a 200' dock directly in front of the Club (enter the west entrance of the Breakwater, proceed east past the Shell gas dock then north to the Club's dock) and during the season, at least 100' of this dock shall be available for reciprocal purposes. In addition, the Club expects to arrange with the Port of Bellingham for reciprocal club members to use BYC members' moorage throughout the harbor (but mostly on dock C-West) without charge for single night stays, as well. Conditions/rules are as follows:

- Day moorage based on space available, no reservation required.
- Reservation required for stays over two days.
- First night is free (*EXCEPT POWER*) for reciprocal club members flying their club burgee.
- All vessels at BYC or members' docks are required to register. Registration envelopes can be found in a box at the end of the reciprocal dock closest to the ramp.
- All port facilities including restrooms and showers are locked at dusk and unlocked at dawn. Contact a BYC member, the Port of Bellingham office or security guard for the current access code.
- Check-out time is 1 PM except by arrangement.
- BYC rates: Electricity \$3/day. Moorage: \$.50/foot per day after the first day.

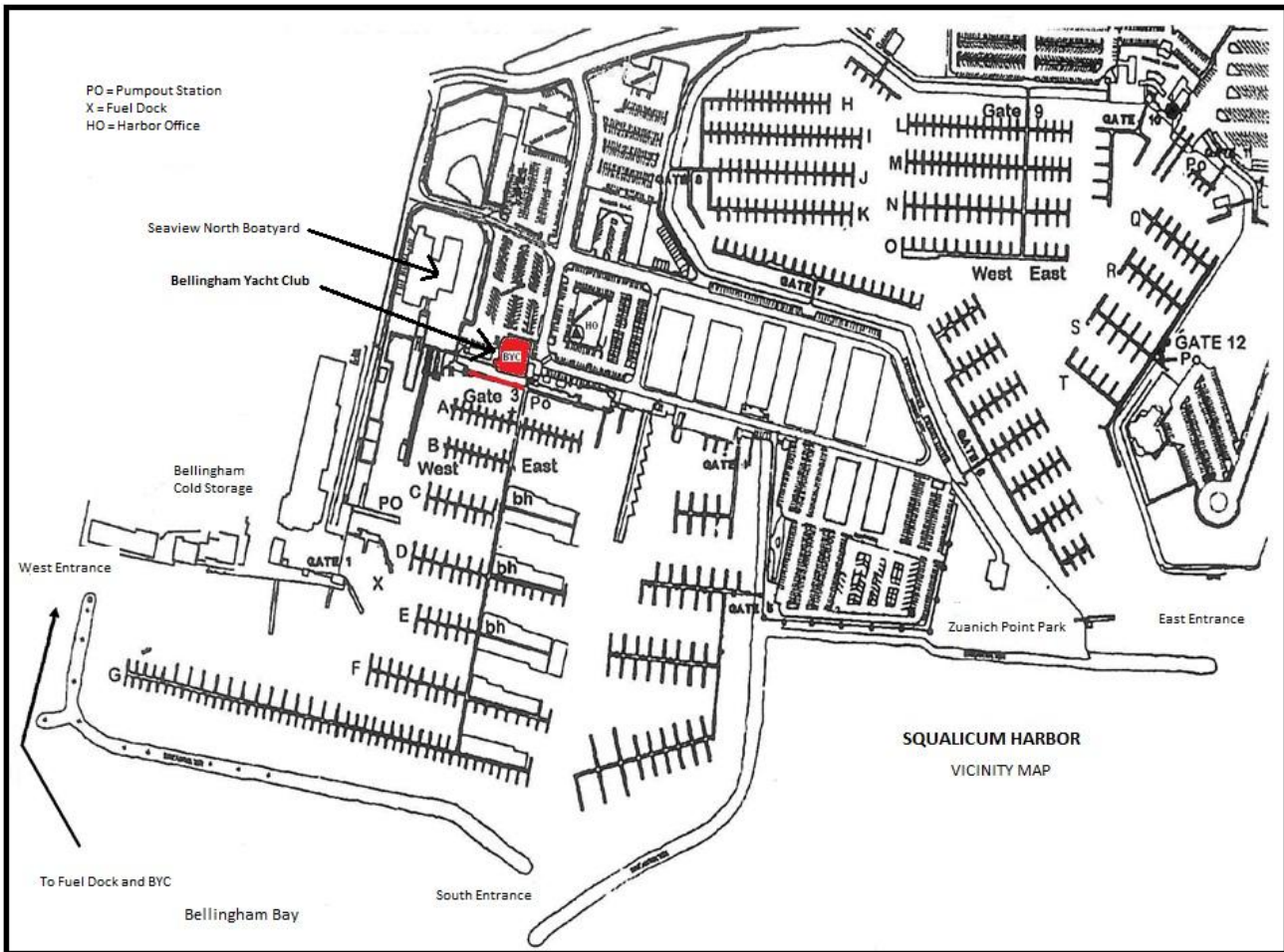
GUESTS REGISTER ON A FORM WHICH INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING CONTRACT:

REGISTRATION AND WAIVER: ANYONE USING THE HARBOR OR ITS FACILITIES DOES SO AT HIS/HER OWN RISK. OPERATOR HEREBY AGREES TO FOREVER RELEASE AND DISCHARGE THE BELLINGHAM YACHT CLUB AND/OR THE PORT OF BELLINGHAM, THEIR SERVANTS, AGENTS, TRUSTEES, OFFICERS, MEMBERS AND EMPLOYEES FROM ANY CLAIMS OR DAMAGE TO THE VESSEL LISTED DURING THE VESSEL'S MOORAGE AT THE CLUB OR PORT'S DOCKS OR ELSEWHERE IN THE HARBOR. OWNER HEREBY RELEASES AND FOREVER DISCHARGES THE BELLINGHAM YACHT CLUB AND/OR THE PORT OF BELLINGHAM FROM ANY AND ALL CLAIMS FOR (1) PERSONAL INJURY AND/OR (2) PROPERTY DAMAGE WHEN SUCH PERSONAL INJURY AND/OR PROPERTY DAMAGE CLAIMS RESULT FROM FIRE: COMBUSTION, DISCHARGE OF CONTAMINANTS, POLLUTION OR ANY OTHER OCCURRENCE ORIGINATING ON, FROM, OR AS A RESULT OF THE VESSEL OPERATOR ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THESE FACILITIES ARE ZERO-DISCHARGE HARBORS, AND HE/SHE WILL ABIDE BY ALL ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATIONS. OPERATOR AGREES TO KEEP HARBOR PREMISES NEAT, CLEAN, AND ORDERLY. ALL PETS MUST BE ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES AND OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANUP OF ANIMAL WASTE. RIDING OF BICYCLES OR OTHER VEHICLES ON DOCKS IS PROHIBITED. SPEED LIMIT IN HARBOR IS FOUR (4) KNOTS. OPERATOR AGREES NOT TO ENGAGE IN ANY COMMERCIAL ENTERPRISE.

FAILURE TO REGISTER BOAT AS REQUIRED WILL INCUR A PENALTY CHARGE IN ADDITION TO NORMAL CHARGES, AND MAY RESULT IN IMPOUNDMENT OF VESSEL.

SQUALICUM HARBOR, BELLINGHAM BAY



In the map above, the Bellingham Yacht Club dock is directly north of the words "Gate 3" through the west breakwater entrance, around to the north past the fuel dock, just past dock "A". The large building just ashore from that dock is the clubhouse. As you see, a portable pump out unit is also just east of the dock, indicated "PO". This unit can be rolled right over to your boat at the BYC dock for holding tank service.

30 amp power and water at each slip, and lit docks and ramps are provided for boaters' convenience and security. Port of Bellingham security is present after hours.

At the head of the ramp to gate 3 are modern restrooms, shower rooms, and a coin-operated laundry. Ice and garbage facilities are just east of the harbor office indicated by the symbol as noted.

In case needed, additional visitors' moorage for non-reciprocal members is operated by the Port of Bellingham at docks "O" and "T" through the east end of the breakwater.
